The Artisticulta Arts Organization proudly presents our second Rising to Fame National Arts Festival from 20-23 March 2019 at the Wild Coast Casino KZN!

**Please note should our program be extended keep the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of March open.**

An online entry system has been designed:

**Take note of the following:** A few questions regarding the items that qualified as well as how to re-qualify again arose from our local Artisticulta Arts Festival rounds if 80% was not achieved at an Artisticulta Arts Festival:

**1. Re-Qualifying rounds**

Participants have a chance to qualify again for Rising to Fame National Arts Festival if he/she did not succeed to qualify at an Artisticulta Arts Festival.

**Dance:** Dancers and teachers can send through a digital video recording of the item to the following whatsapp number +27 74 728 7065. All videos will be downloaded onto a computer where an adjudicator will judge the item in question. The participant WILL NOT receive a medal or certificate but will solely be judged on if she/he/D/T or Group qualifies to enter for Rising to Fame. Items must be recorded properly and named correctly. We will notify the participants / teacher of the items that qualified. Please provide us with contact details, email address and studio name / dancers name and surname that must accompany the video.

**Drama:** Drama & orator participants and teachers can send through a digital video recording of the item to the following whatsapp number +27 66 250 4139. All videos will be downloaded onto a computer where an adjudicator will judge the item in question. The participant WILL NOT receive a medal or certificate but will solely be judged on if she/he/D/T or Group sections qualifies to enter for Rising to Fame. Items must be recorded properly and named correctly as if entering for an Artisticulta Arts Festival. We will notify the participant / teacher of the items that qualified. Please provide us with contact details, email address and studio name / dancers name and surname that must accompany the video.

**Music:** Music and vocal participants and teachers can send through a digital video recording of the item to the following whatsapp number +27 073 511 5415. All videos will be downloaded onto a computer where an adjudicator will judge the item in question. The participant WILL NOT receive a medal or certificate but will solely be judged on if she/he/D/T or Group sections qualifies to enter for Rising to Fame. Items must be recorded properly and named correctly as if entering for an Artisticulta Arts Festival. We will notify the participant / teacher of the items that qualified. Please provide us with contact details, email address and studio name / dancers name and surname that must accompany the video.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THESE RE-QUALIFYING ENTRIES ARE ONLY FOR THE PROVINCES WHERE AN ARTISTICULTA ARTS FESTIVAL DID NOT TAKE PLACE AND FOR PARTICIPANTS THAT RECEIVED 75% AND UP AT AN ARTISTICULTA FESTIVAL IN 2018.**

- **The re-qualifying rounds open on 1 November 2018 – 16 January 2019.**
- **The online entry system opens on 1 November 2017. Closing date for all entries for Rising to Fame is 31 January 2019!**

## **2. How to enter?**

Please go to [www.artisticulta.co.za](http://www.artisticulta.co.za) On the menu bar click on Rising to Fame icon. Attached find all the info, rules and regulations of each art form. There will be a link of how to enter on each Art forms icon. Entries for Dance and Drama can only be done on the internet. Entries for Music can be done either by internet or attached entry form.

## **3. Recommended amount of entries per participant to enter for Rising to Fame?**

It is recommended that the participant should enter at least three items for Rising to Fame, as it gives the participants an even chance to win one of our grand prizes. It is however not compulsory. Fewer items can also be entered.

## **4. SA National colors for Rising to Fame?**

Please note that we are in the process of applying for SA National colors which is a very long and expensive process. This year all participants will receive a Rising to Fame T-shirt and backpack.

## **5. Prizes, trophies, medals, holiday vouchers, bursaries and sponsorships**

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Grand money prizes for each art form are to be won.
- Medals will be handed out to the first three section winners of each art form.
- Trophies for participants for each art form.
- All participants receive certificates.
- Special prizes such as bursaries, holiday vouchers and gift vouchers will be handed out to each art form, from our sponsors.
- Discount packages to be won for the teachers who has the most entries for 2019 Rising to Fame National art Festival.

The Rising to Fame National Arts Festival is where provinces come together to compete against one another to determine our South African team that will represent us at the Arnold Classic International Arts Festival from 17-19 May 2019 at Crawford College Santon.

Details of the grand prizes will be conveyed to all at a later stage.

## **6. A few questions regarding the DANCE/DRAMA & MUSIC entries?**

- D/T, groups, formations & productions in all the art forms
  - If a group of 6 participants qualified, and two participants cancels their dance classes the teacher is allowed to replace these learners with existing learners that also qualified for Rising to Fame so that it does not influence choreography. The group can still enter under 6 participants. Please note that the two learners that are being used as replacements should be on the same level as the other learners. Another option is that the teacher only enters the group as 4 dancers if there are no replacements. The teacher cannot add more learners than the

original group that qualified; in this case only 6 participants can enter for this item.

- Name of the item that qualified?
  - Please note the name of the item can change. If a dancer qualified for a solo: Love you lots (item name), 12 and under, Pre-Amateur, Modern, Solo, the name is allowed to change but not the age, section, style and status.
- Choreography of all items
  - Please note that teachers and participants are welcome to change choreography. As mentioned only the age, section, style and status cannot change for this is what the dancer(s) qualified for.
- Age groups and status
  - The dancer qualified 12 and under for her item in 2018 but turned 13 end of 2018. The participant must enter under the correct age group as from 1 December 2018.
  - Please note dancers are allowed to move up a status but not down a status or the dancer can stay in the status as qualified.
- If dancers received 80% and above at the Rising to Fame National Arts Festival they automatically move up a status for the Arnold Classic International Arts Festival.
